## Note for 2021

The organizing committee has spent considerable time planning this year's Convention and will be doing everything to ensure that it is held complying with all Government guidelines in place at the time.

With your registration form we have included a more detailed letter setting out our plans. Please read this as it also lists areas where you can find more information if there are any changes required between now and the Convention date.

To assist our planning we have therefore set a more limited time frame to register to attend, or order notes only if you cannot attend.

If you require notes only your order must be returned by 19 July so that we have an accurate number of notes to get printed.

Due to Covid restrictions we are still working with the caterers to ascertain what catering arrangements there will be, but we are planning that some form of catering will be available.

As the last twelve months have shown how quickly things can change we would urge interstate visitors to watch the SA Government website to ascertain whether BORDER PASSES are required at the time of the convention.
